Holy Rosary Cluster

To the Members of Holy Rosary Cluster:

We priests recently received the following emails from Archbishop Jackels:

1. (dated August 17) "Please consider taking up a second collection in your parish(es) for Haiti relief. Thousands were killed in the earthquake last weekend, many more thousands injured, buildings collapsed, and public utilities were cut off. Humanitarian aid groups sprang into action almost immediately, not only providing help in the affected areas, but also calling upon a global solidarity for donations. There are local connections to Haiti. Many parishes have sister-parishes there. And we have a priest from Haiti, Fr. Frantz Augustin, serving with Fr. Kevin Earleywine [Hampton and Ackley].

"The major earthquake that struck Haiti this past weekend is only one in a long string of tragedies: Many other devastating earthquakes, hurricanes, flooding, a cholera epidemic, COVID, gang violence, the assassination of its president, crushing poverty, just to name a few...Absolutely 100% of what's donated will be donated to Catholic Relief Services."

I recently contacted the office of the missionary group that was supposed to present our annual mission appeal in July to see if they wanted to reschedule; I have not heard back from them (as of today, August 24, when I'm writing this column). Since it thus appears that we will <u>not</u> have a mission appeal this year, and since this appeal for relief for Haiti is a most worthwhile and urgently needed cause, I therefore encourage you to contribute to this appeal (I will be doing so as well).

If you write out a check, make it out to your parish and note it is for "Haiti relief" (or similar words)--you can either put your check in the collection basket at Mass or send it to the cluster office. If you'd like to make a cash donation, put it in an envelope and mark it "Haiti relief" and drop it in the collection basket. We will then write one check for each of the cluster parishes from your donations which will then be sent to Dubuque. As the archbishop said, 100% of our donations will go to Catholic Relief Services which is involved in this Haitian relief effort. Thank you in advance for your generosity.

2. (dated August 18) The archbishop forwarded to us the following message from Pope Francis encouraging us to receive the COVID vaccination:

"In a brotherly spirit, I join in this message of hope for a brighter future. Thanks to God and to the work of many, we now have vaccines to protect us from COVID-19. They grant us the hope of ending the pandemic, but only if they are available to all and if we work together.

"Being vaccinated with vaccines authorized by the competent authorities is an act of love. And contributing to ensure the majority of people are vaccinated is an act of love. Love for oneself, love for one's family and friends, love for all people. Love is also social and political, there is social love and political love; it is universal, always overflowing with small gestures of personal charity capable of transforming and improving societies.

"Vaccination is a simple but profound way of promoting the common good and caring for each other, especially the most vulnerable. I pray to God that everyone may contribute their own small grain of sand, their own small gesture of love; no matter how small, love is always great. Contribute with these small gestures for a better future."

I'm well aware of the controversies surrounding the vaccination issue and the strong and conflicting opinions regarding whether vaccination should be required and other related issues. Of course, you need to make your own decision based on a well-formed conscience as well as your own particular situation. I offer these words from the Holy Father because they do remind us of an important factor in our decision-making: the need to prayerfully consider the common good of all along with our own personal circumstances. In any event, I'm sure we all agree on the need to continue praying for an end to the pandemic and for the relief of those suffering from the virus or other illnesses.
