

Holy Rosary Cluster

To the Members of Holy Rosary Cluster:

1. I want to give you a bit of a medical update. I've told you before that the yearly check-ups after my surgeries in 2018 have gone very well--no new growths on my kidneys--and that continues to be the case. After my annual physical in April, my doctor told me that my PSA (prostate) numbers had gone up a bit. Further blood work in July showed more of an increase, and so a biopsy was done last month--the results of which show that I have prostate cancer. I will soon be scheduling a bone scan and a CAT scan to see whether or not the cancer is contained in the prostate. The results of those scans will then help determine what the next step will be; at this point, radiation or surgery (removal of the prostate) appear to be the main options.

I want to assure you that I feel very well and, as I told the archbishop, I have every intention of remaining here at Holy Rosary Cluster--and he is just fine with that! The love and the grace of God are amazingly powerful; I think we have all come to know and experience that in so many ways. I won't say this diagnosis is the best news I've ever heard, but I'm very glad to know about it so as to figure out the next steps. I will keep you fully informed through this whole process; I would very much appreciate your prayers. And I continue to pray daily for all of you and all your loved ones.

2. This month of October is traditionally devoted to the Rosary, and it is especially fitting for us here in Holy Rosary Cluster to give special attention to this powerful prayer. In 2002 Pope St. John Paul II issued a beautiful document on the Rosary, a prayer for which he had a special devotion. It was in this letter that he introduced the Five Luminous Mysteries (the mysteries of light) that focus on major events of Jesus' public life and ministry.

In this letter, the pope had this to say about the "Hail Mary" which is repeated throughout the Rosary:

"The center of gravity in the *Hail Mary*, the hinge as it were which joins its two parts, is *the name of Jesus*. Sometimes, in hurried recitation, this center of gravity can be overlooked, and with it the connection to the mystery of Christ being contemplated. Yet it is precisely the emphasis given to the name of Jesus and to his mystery that is the sign of a meaningful and fruitful recitation of the Rosary."

That is a really important point. In the "Hail Mary" we are indeed addressing Mary; we echo the words spoken to her both by the Archangel Gabriel and her cousin Elizabeth. But we join the latter in saying "...and blessed is the fruit of thy womb: <u>Jesus</u>." Mary is blessed because God blessed her in wonderfully powerful ways. And God did so precisely to prepare her for bringing his Son and our Savior into the world for us. Jesus truly is at the heart, the center of the "Hail Mary". The more we remember that, the more fruitful will be our praying the Rosary and reflecting with gratitude on its mysteries. ~ Fr. Kopacek

World Mission Sunday



IRS regulations require the farmer to:

- 1) inform the elevator that he/she is **gifting** the grain to their parish.
- 2) the farmer needs to sign a donation form to the elevator.
- 3) the elevator will complete the form and inform the parish office of the gift.
- 4) the parish will immediately tell the elevator to sell the grain and send proceeds to the parish.

At no time in this process can the farmer receive payment from the elevator for the grain; the grain must be gifted through the elevator to the parish. If you have any questions contact the cluster office at 641-393-2520.
