

Holy Rosary Cluster

To the Members of Holy Rosary Cluster:

1. Two scheduling items:

please note that there will be no 8 a.m. Mass on Monday, Sept. 18, in Elma. I have a meeting in Cedar Rapids Sunday evening (the 17th) and commitments in Waterloo the next day. I'll be back Monday evening.

all are invited to the Elma church hall next Sunday, Sept. 24, to watch "Mother Teresa: No Greater Love". This is an excellent film, produced with the support of the Knights of Columbus, about one of the most remarkable saints in the whole history of the Church and who lived in our own time (she died in 1997). We will begin at 2:30 p.m. (not 2 p.m. as originally scheduled).

2. In the homily two weeks ago I spoke about how we don't always understand or even see God's plan for us in the messiness of life--but that is because we can't see the whole picture. I also shared with you a reflection titled "The Embroidery" (by an unknown author) that I think illustrates this point very well. Here is that reflection:

"When I was a little boy, my mother used to embroider a great deal. I would sit at her knee and look up from the floor and ask what she was doing. She said she was embroidering. From the underside I saw her work within the boundaries of the little round hoop she held in her hand, and I complained that it sure looked messy from where I sat. I also wondered why she was using some dark threads along with the bright ones. She would smile, look down and gently say, 'My son, you go about your playing, and when I'm finished, I'll put you on my knee and let you see it from my side.'

"A few minutes would pass and then Mother said, 'Son, come and sit on my knee.' This I did, only to be surprised and thrilled to see a beautiful flower or a sunset. I couldn't believe it, because from underneath it looked so messy. Then Mother would say, 'My son, from underneath it did look messy and jumbled, but you did not realize that there was a pre-drawn plan on the top. It was a design; I was only following it. Now, look at it from my side and you will see what I was doing.'

"Many times through the years I have looked up to my Heavenly Father and said, 'Father, what are you doing?' He answered, 'I am embroidering your life.' I would say, 'But it looks like a mess to me; it seems so jumbled; the threads seem so dark. Why can't they all be bright?' The Father seems to tell me, 'My child, you go about your business of doing my business, and one day I will bring you to Heaven and put you on my knee and you will see the plan from my side.'

I <u>really</u> like this image! As I told you two weeks ago, I don't embroider--but I've seen many examples of such work over the years. And when looking at the bottom side, it seems like nothing other than a meaningless, random bunch of threads. But, of course, on the other side you see the beautiful pattern and how all the threads and colors work together so harmoniously and beautifully. God grant that we continue to grow in faith and trust so that one day we will all be able to see the glorious completion of God's 'embroidery' of our lives.

3. "Don't Forget to Laugh!" One of the many books on my humor shelf is "1000 Unforgettable Senior Moments" by Tom Friedman--a collection of true stories of real absent-mindedness on the part of some famous people. Having more and more of those moments myself as the years roll by. I find comfort in knowing I'm not the only one! A couple of examples:

• "When Albert Einstein [one of the greatest scientific geniuses of all time] received a \$1500 check from the Rockefeller Foundation as an honorarium, he used it as a bookmark for months, then lost the book. Trying to keep its records in order, the Foundation sent a duplicate check, and Einstein, having forgotten the first one, wrote back, "What's this for?"

'When SIr John Gielgud told Elizabether Taylor that Richard Burton's acting had gone downhill 'since he married that terrible woman,' he had clearly forgotten that the woman Burton had married in 1964 was Taylor herself.'
