

Holy Rosary Cluster

To the Members of Holy Rosary Cluster:

- 1. Please note that we will celebrate our annual Knights of Columbus Mass at Immaculate Conception church in Elma this Monday, Nov. 6, at 6 p.m. Because of that evening Mass, there will be no 8 a.m. Mass in Elma that day.
- 2. I was recently asked by one of our cluster members if I had sent him a text that had my name on it. This was obviously one of the countless scam attempts that are being attempted these days. Please know that if I ever want to contact you, I will either phone or email you--I am not a texter on any regular basis at all. My flip phone allows me to receive and send texts, but sending them is not the quick and easy process it is for those with smartphones. So if you ever get an unsolicited text that looks like it was sent by me, go ahead and delete it right away.
- 3. This month of November is the last full month of the current church year; the new church year begins on December 3-- the first Sunday of Advent. And so it makes sense that the Church invites us to give special attention at this time to our ultimate destination--the heavenly kingdom of God. Last Wednesday, November 1, we celebrated All Saints Day--honoring all those souls who are already in heaven and who await being reunited with their bodies at the general resurrection. The older I get, the more I come to appreciate our Catholic devotion to the saints--they are the heroes and heroines of our faith, who show us in so many different ways what being a disciple of Jesus looks like. But the saints are also our friends and fellow members of the Body of Christ, the Church, and they are cheering us on in our path to holiness. The Catechism speaks of this:

"Being more closely united to Christ, those who dwell in heaven fix the whole Church more firmly in holiness...They do not cease to intercede with the Father for us...So by their fraternal concern is our weakness greatly helped" (n. 956, quoting Vatican II's Constitution on the Church).

How blessed we are to have the saints on our side, giving us such great help by the power of the example and intercession on our behalf! May we never tire of learning more about the saints, being inspired by their example, and seeking their prayers on our behalf.

4. "Don't Forget to Laugh!" While attending a marriage preparation weekend, Walter and Ann heard the instructor say "It is essential that husbands and wives know the little things that are important to each other. For example: guys, can you name your wife-to-be's favorite flower?" Walter leaned over, touched Ann's arm gently, and whispered, 'Gold Medal All Purpose, isn't it?"
